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MODERN HISTORY OF SCHOOL CHOICE

Our increasingly global economy highlighted the need for higher-level skills, while drawing attention to longstanding inequities in education.

Parents and teachers worked together to create new options (1983-ongoing)

- Private school choice (starting in Wisconsin)
- Public charter schools (starting in Minnesota)
- Online public schools (starting in Florida)

Existing education options expanded (2000-ongoing)

- Expansion of open enrollment
- New themes and focus for magnet schools
- Improvement of homeschooling laws

- Know and exercise options for your family
- Share experiences with other parents
- Be an ambassador for your child's school (if you are happy!)
- Speak up and be present at meetings, hearings, and other events
